CLASS NOTICE PLAN AND NOTICE
ADMINISTRATOR**

1 The Court, having read and considered the Parties' Joint Status Report re Class Notice,
2 the Declaration of Mark Schey Regarding Class Certification Notice ("Schey Declaration"),
3 Plaintiff's proposed Class Notice forms and Defendant's objections, and the arguments of counsel
4 at the January 14, 2026 Status Conference, on the record, hereby ORDERS as follows:

5 1. Approval of Notice Plan:

6 Plaintiff's proposed Class Notice plan is **APPROVED**. The Court finds that the Notice
7 Plan constitutes the best notice practicable under the circumstances and satisfies the requirements
8 of California Rules of Court, rule 3.766(d), and provides the requisite due process to the Class.

9 2. Approval of Notice Content:

10 The Court **APPROVES** the content of Plaintiff's proposed Long Form Notice and Short
11 Form Notice, submitted as **Exhibits A** and **B** to the Schey Declaration, respectively.

12 3. Notice Administrator:

13 Digital Settlement, LLC is approved and appointed as the Notice Administrator for
14 purposes of implementing the approved Notice Plan.

15 4. Provision of Contact Information:

16 Within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order, Defendant shall provide to the Notice
17 Administrator the names and email addresses of potential Class Members in Defendant's
18 possession, custody, or control, for purposes of effectuating direct email notice.

19 5. Commencement of Notice:

20 Class Notice shall commence within fourteen (14) days after Defendant provides the
21 required contact information to the Notice Administrator.

22 6. Opt-Out Period:

23 Class Members shall have forty-five (45) days from the commencement of notice to
24 request exclusion from the Class. The Court **APPROVES** the content of Plaintiff's proposed
25 Exclusion Request Form, submitted as **Exhibit C** to the Schey Declaration.

26 7. Costs of Notice:

27 Plaintiff shall bear the costs of implementing the approved Notice Plan, without prejudice

1 to any later request for reimbursement.
